Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Preschool Program Read it Again

As we are nearing the completion of the Read It Again program on Tuesday/Thursday, it is strongly encouraged that the concepts that have been explored are reinforced at home. When reading with your child, ask them to tell you about;

Print Knowledge – Discuss the title, title page, author, illustrator. Count how many words are in the title. After reading the title, what do you think the story is about? Can they find any letters that are in their name etc.

Vocabulary – There are so many words that we assume the children know. Check in occasionally with a word or two in the book. For example, 'what does grin mean?' **Phonological awareness** – Rhyming words, breaking down words into syllables (clap once for each syllable eg An -drew, Mar-vell-ous), opposites and sequencing events. These concepts can be targeted through games while you're driving in the car or waiting for something.

Narrative

- Beginning the kick-off event
- Middle The main part of the story
- Ending How did it finish? Was it a happy ending?
- Characters (bossy, kind, tall, friendly). They will use adjectives to describe them.
- Setting where are the children playing? What is the setting of the story. The pictures will provide lots of clues.

Please remember to enjoy reading with your child. Only one or two of these concepts should be explored at one time. We want children to love stories and reading, it is important to explore these concepts organically and to not overwhelm them.

Fire Safety visit – Tuesday 7th November

- We will observe what firefighters wear and recognise that although they may look scary with their masks on, they are safe people and are there to help you in the event of an emergency.

- We will learn what to do if there is a fire at our home. Where is your family meeting place? We will be learning the importance of knowing your address and how to make a call to the fire brigade.
- We will learn what to do if our clothes are on fire.
